SECOND SCHEDULE

[Order 2]

1. AGRICULTURE:

- (a) Land development schemes covering an area of 500 hectares or more to bring forest land into agricultural production.
- (b) New pig farming area of 2,000 SPP (Standing Pig Population) or more.

2. AERODROME:

- (a) Any aerodrome development in or adjacent to State or National Parks or National Marine Parks or island surrounding Marine Parks or any gazetted protected areas.
- (b) Upgrading of aerodrome which involves land reclamation or coastal reclamation of more than 50 hectares.

3. CONSTRUCTION OF DAM:

- (a) Construction of *all* dams or impounding reservoirs for the purpose of irrigation, *flood mitigation, siltation, recreational* or water supply with a surface area of *100 hectares* or more.
- (b) Dams and hydro-electric power schemes with either or both of the following:
 - dams over 15 metres high and ancillary structures covering a total area in excess of 40 hectares;
 - (ii) reservoirs with a surface area in excess of 100 hectares.

4. DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION:

- (a) Construction of man-made lakes and artificial enlargement of lakes with surface areas of 100 hectares or more in or adjacent to Environmental Sensitive Area.
- (b) Any drainage of wetland, wild-life habitat or of virgin forest covering an area of 100 hectares or more.

5. FISHERIES

Land based aquaculture projects accompanied by clearing of mangrove swamp forest *or fresh water swamp* covering an area of *50 hectares or more.*

6. FORESTRY

- (a) Conversion of forest land more than 300 m asl (above sea level) to other land use covering an area of more than 50 hectares.
- (b) Logging *or removal or extraction of timber* within:
 (i) the catchment area of reservoirs used for municipal water supply, irrigation or hydro-power generation; or
 - (ii) in areas adjacent to state parks, national parks or national marine parks; or (iii) areas in *state parks, national parks or national marine parks.*
- (c) Logging or removal or extraction of timber of forest land of more than 300 m asl (above sea level).
- (d) Logging or removal or extraction of timber covering an area of 500 hectares or more.
- (e) Conversion of mangrove swamps for industrial, housing or agricultural use covering an area of 50 hectares or more.
- (f) Clearing of mangrove swamps on islands adjacent to national marine parks.

7. SLOPE DEVELOPMENT

- (a) Any development involving land clearing where 50% of the area or more in Class III (area with $\geq 25^{\circ}$ to $<35^{\circ}$) or having slope of 25° or more.
- (b) Construction of road infrastructure, tunnel or bridge traversing Class IV areas (area with $\geq 35^{\circ}$).

8. INDUSTRY

(a)	Non-ferrous:	-Primary smelting:
		Aluminium-all sizes.
		Copper-all sizes.
		Other-producing 50 tonnes/day or more of product.
(b)	Non-metallic; Cement:- Cement: with clinker production capacity of 30	
		tonnes/hour and above.
(c)	Iron and steel:	- Require iron one as raw materials for production
		greater than 100 tonnes/day; or
		- Using scrap iron as raw materials for production
		greater than 200 tonnes/day.

- (d) Petrochemicals: -In area not designated for industry where production capacity of each product or of combined products is 50 tonnes.day or more
- *(e) Pulp; or pulp and paper: -* Production capacity greater than 50 tonnes/day.
- (f) Recycle Paper Industry:- Production capacity greater than 50 tonnes/day.

9. LAND RECLAMATION

- (a) Coastal reclamation *or land reclamation along river banks* involving area of 50 hectares or more.
- (b) Reclamation for man-made island

10. MINING

Mining of minerals in new areas for application of the mining lease.

11. PETROLEUM:

Construction of oil refineries.

12. PORTS:

Construction of ports or fishing harbours.

13. POWER GENERATION AND TRANSMISSION:

- (a) Construction of coal fired power plant.
- (b) Construction of nuclear-fuel power stations.

14. RESORT, RECREATIONAL AND INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- (a) Development of tourist or recreational facilities or *institutions* in national *and state* parks.
- (b) Development of tourist or recreational facilities or *institutions* on islands in surrounding waters which are gazetted as national marine park.
- (c) Development of tourist or recreational facilities or institutions on islands in surrounding waters which are gazetted as turtle nesting beaches.

15. WASTE TREATMENT & DISPOSAL

(a) Scheduled Waste:-

(i) Construction of Thermal Treatment Plant.

(ii) Construction of off-site recovery plant for lead acid battery wastes.
(iii) Construction of off-site recovery plant or treatment facility that generates significant amount of wastewater which is located upstream of public water supply intake.

(iv) Construction of secure landfill facility.

- (b) Solid Waste:-
 - (i) Construction of Thermal Treatment Plant
 - (ii) Construction of sanitary landfill facility.
 - (iii) Construction of transfer station.

16. RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS AND RADIOACTIVE WASTE

Any prescribed activities that using radioactive materials and generating radioactive wastes.
